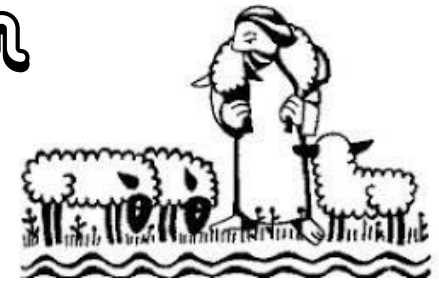

- Jeremiah 4:11-12, 22-28 God speaks his judgement over his people: they only know how to do evil, but do not know God.
- Psalm 14 Only fools do not care about God!
- 1 Timothy 1:12-17 The two letters to Timothy and the one to Titus are called "pastoral epistles" because they contain advice esp. for leaders in the church ('pastor' means 'shepherd' in Latin).
- Luke 15:1-10 Jesus tells those who criticise him, because he eats with sinners, two stories about how they should rather celebrate that he brings people back to God.

Where ever the prophet Jeremiah looks, nobody is left.

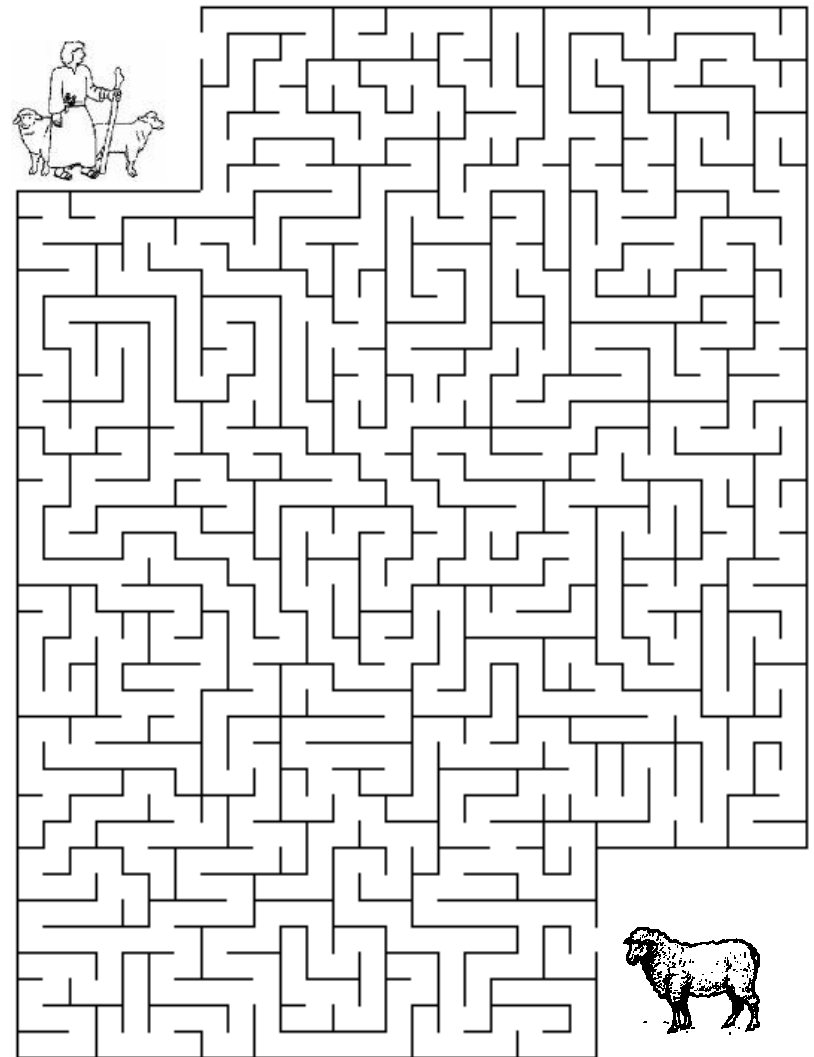
