A Confused Message About Money

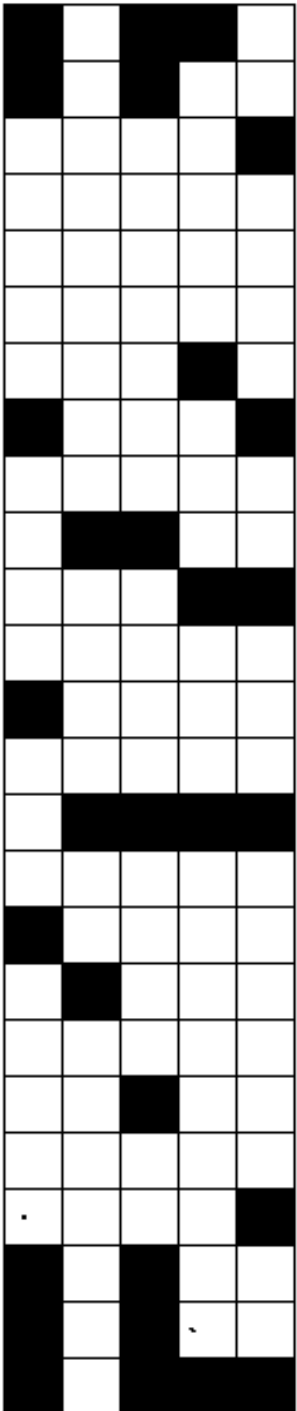
In today's lesson from the First Letter to Timothy we find what the Bible has to say about money

The world might be as full of dangers as this puzzle is full of words to be found—, still we live in the shelter of God, the Most High!

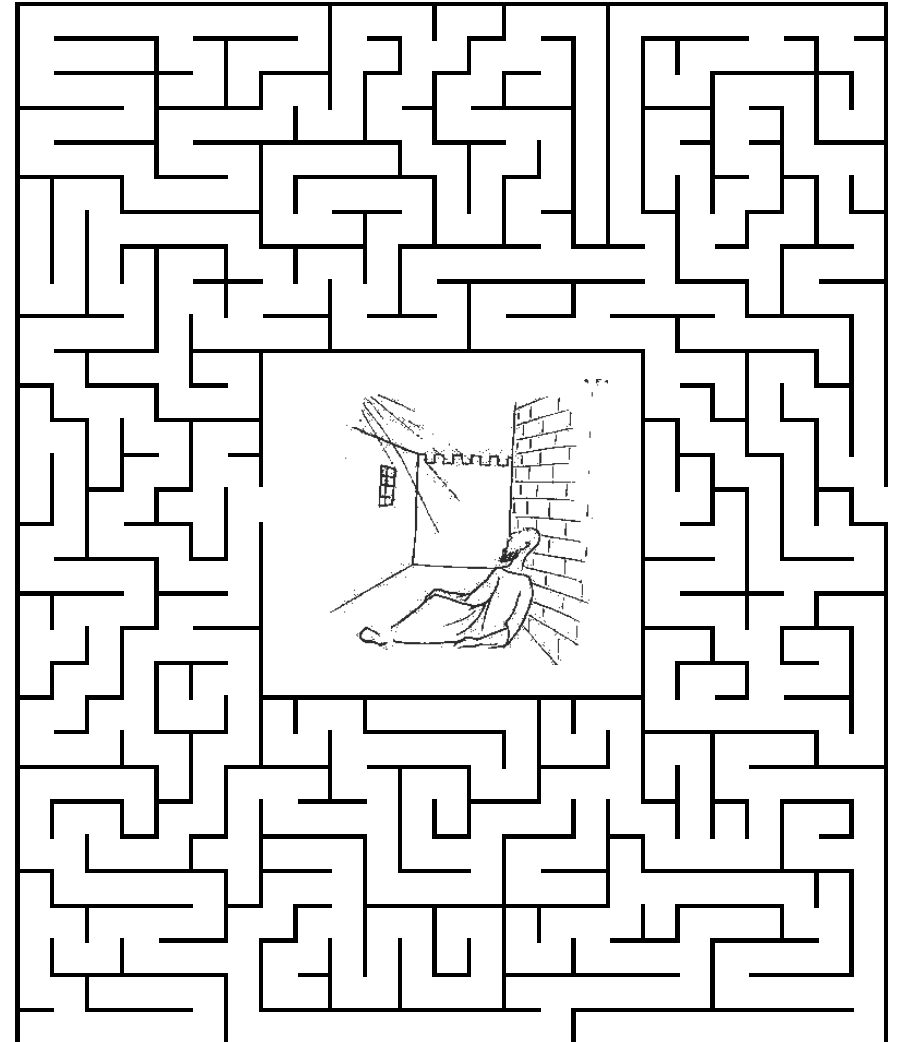
