Today's lessons:

- Lamentations 1:1-6 Jerusalem has been destroyed by the Babylonians (586 B.C.), just like the Prophet Jeremiah predicted. The book of Lamentations contains five poems full of sadness and mourning over this loss.
- Psalms 137 The people of Israel have been led away to exile in Babylon, where they remember Jerusalem with songs of mourning and dream about revenge.
- 2 Timothy 1:1-14 The apostle Paul passes on the gospel to his assistant Timothy, and prepares him and all Christians for the time, when Paul himself will not be alive anymore.
- Luke 17:5-10 When the disciples ask Jesus for greater faith, he makes it clear to them that their faith doesn't deserve the name: the disciples are not in a position to make demands, but are called to serve!

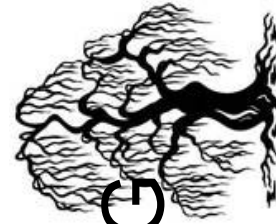

The Book of Lamentations is full of sighs:

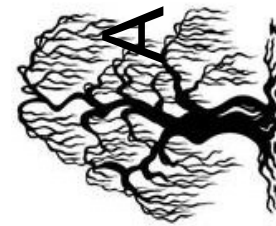
