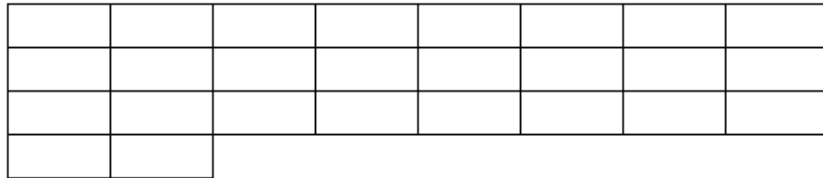
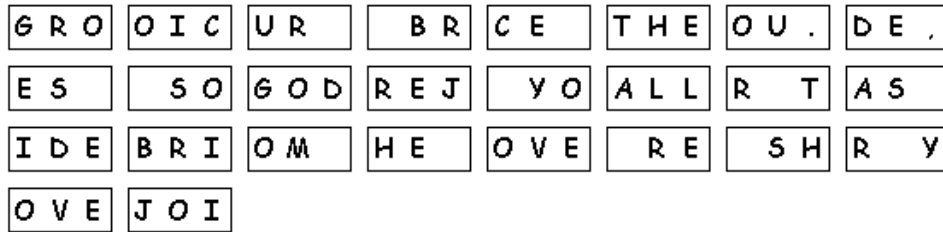


Just like a wedding

If you manage to sort these letter tiles, you will know why.

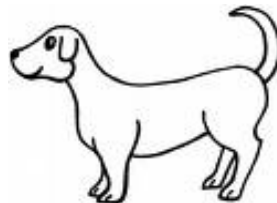

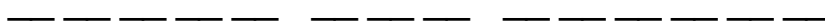
Unwanted Christmas present or surprising sun-blocker ?

Today's lessons:

- Isaiah 62:1-5 God promises his people to bring back the good times, comparing their future relationship to a honeymoon with him as the groom and Israel as the bride.
- Psalm 36:5-10 Because of his love, God provides for humankind and animals, giving them all they need and much more than that.
- 1 Corinthians 12:1-11 It's not necessary that all are the same and have the same gifts: in the church different people with different gifts come together, sharing and serving one another.
- John 2:1-11 Jesus is invited at a wedding where they run out of wine. His mother wants him to do something, but Jesus seems unwilling. Yet Jesus takes action, and six large jars of water are turned into the best wine.
