Paul summarizes in Romans 7 the situation he finds himself in under the Law:

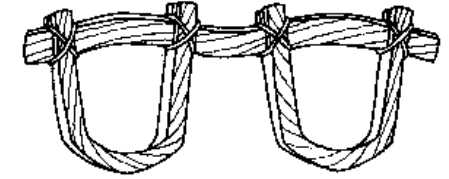

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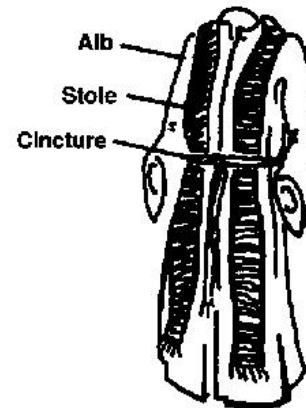

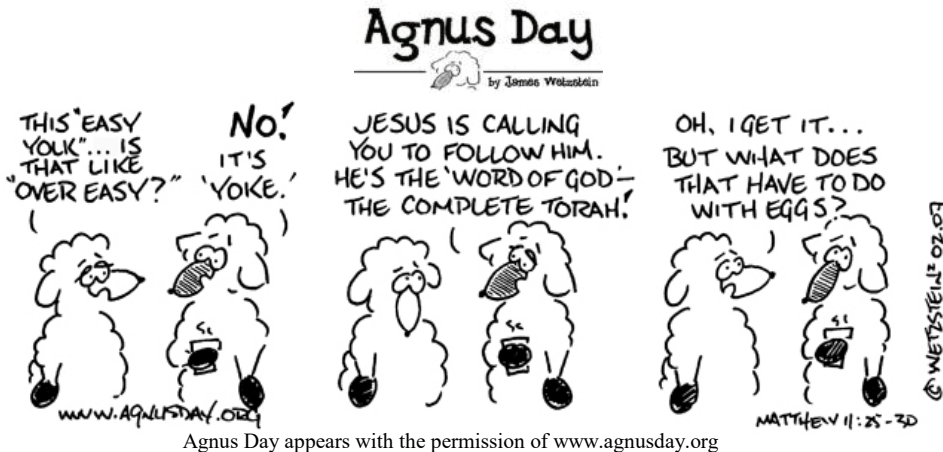
Today's lessons:

- Genesis 24:34-38, 42-49, 58-67 Abraham has sent his servant to find a wife for Isaac among his relatives back home. Meeting Rebekah at the well, the servant realizes that she is the one, and Rebekah agrees to become Isaac's wife.
- Psalms 45:10-17 Originally written for the wedding of a Jewish king, early Christians read this psalm as relating to Christ, the King, and his bride, the Church.
- Romans 7:15-25a Paul realizes that we are not the masters of our own actions: although we know what we should do, we actually don't do it because Sin is our slave-master.
- Matthew 11:16-19, 25-30 Jesus compares his own ministry to that of John the Baptist: although John was fasting and Jesus is feasting a lot of people found fault with both. But Jesus' has come for those who need him – not to please people.

The stole that ministers wear during the service symbolizes the 'yoke of Christ'.



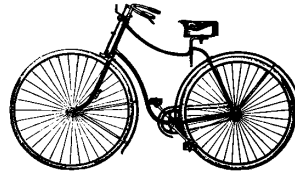

But while what Jesus says to them in today's gospel has something to do with transportation it is not this:

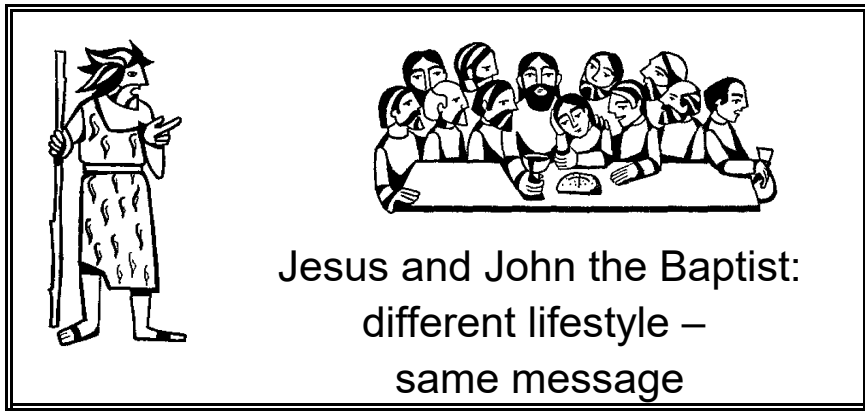
