WOULDN'T IT BE EASIER TO JUST SAY THAT INSTEAD OF KILLING HIM OFF ALL OVER AGAIN?

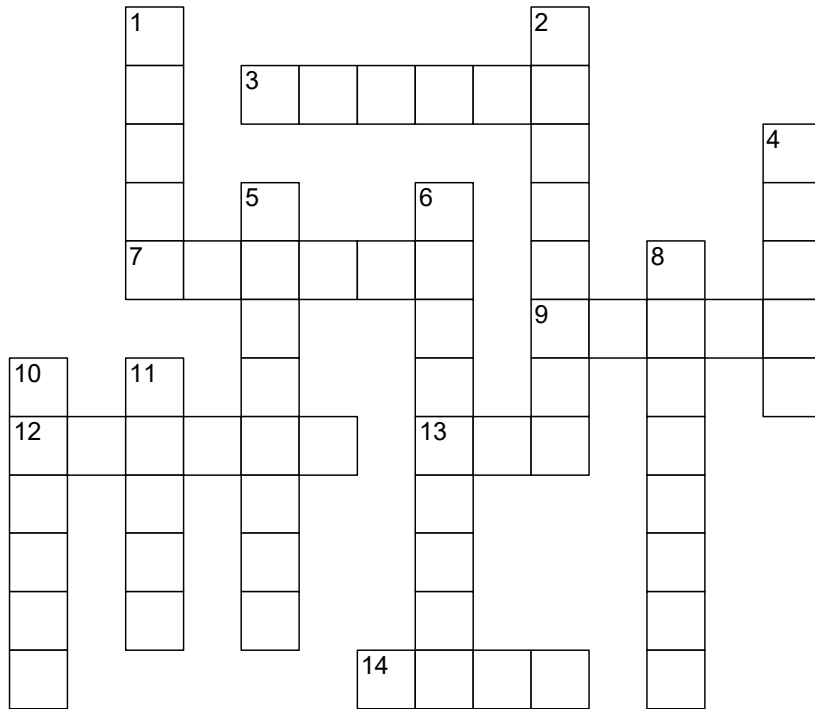
