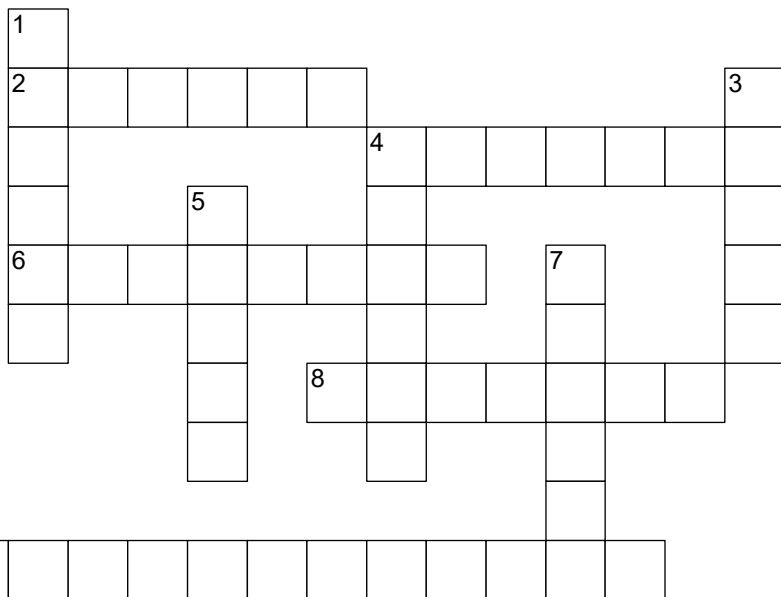

Today's lessons:

- Acts 17:22-31 When visiting the city of Athens (Greece), the apostle Paul finds an altar dedicated 'to an unknown God' and takes that as a preaching opportunity.
- Psalms 66:8-20 God has put his people through hard times, but he has also protected and saved them.
- 1 Peter 3:13-22 You may have to suffer for your faith in Jesus Christ. Keep in mind that he himself suffered for you while himself being innocent. And follow his example of gentleness even towards those who tortured him.
- John 14:15-21 At the Last Supper, Jesus gives his disciples instructions for the time, when he won't be with them in person, and promises them the Holy Spirit instead.

Speaking of our faith in a foreign or maybe even hostile environment is not easy, as the apostle Paul and many other missionaries have experienced.



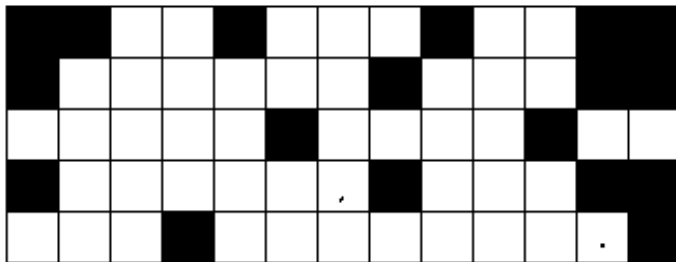
TANK NOW, GOOD NUN!
