Today's lessons:

Acts 1:15-17, 21-26 Because Judas Iscariot has first become a traitor and then committed suicide, the Twelve (disciples) Jesus had chosen to go and proclaim the Gospel are now one apostle short of their number. So they look for men who have been witnesses to everything that happened from Jesus' baptism to his resurrection. Joseph and Matthias both fulfill the requirement, and God decides on Matthias as the twelfth apostle.

Psalms 1 It is good for us to stick to God's word and learn what he wants us to do.

1 John 5:9-13 God himself testifies to the fact that he sent his son to give us life in him.

John 17:6-19 After the Last Supper with his disciples, Jesus prays for them and their unity. Jesus leaves his disciples in the world while he himself is going to the Father. But they, too, belong to God and stand under his protection while they continue Jesus' work in the world.

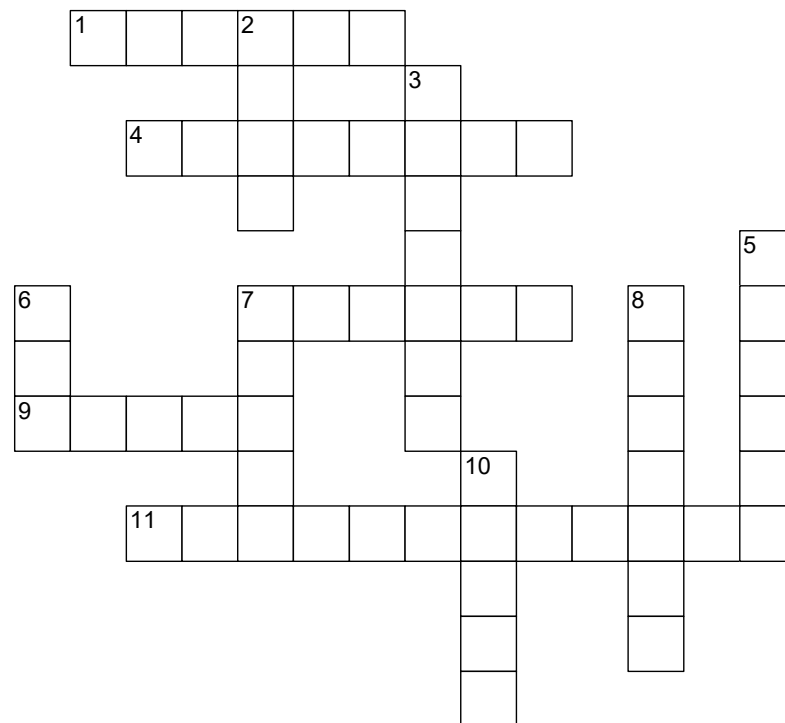
