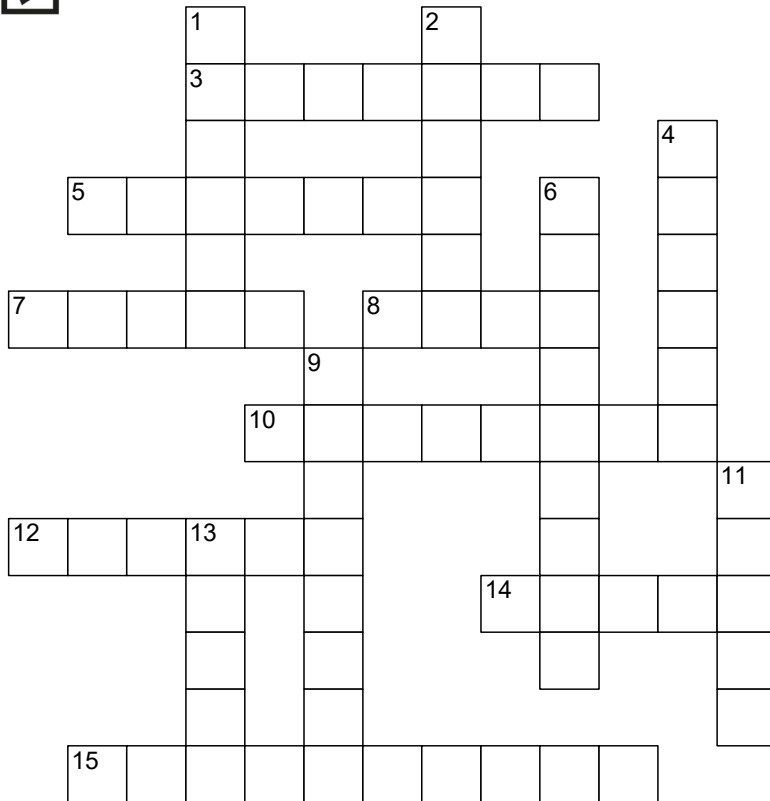


# Jesus passes the test
