March 15, 2020

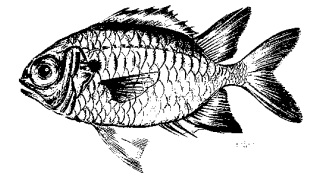


Today's lessons:

- Exodus 17:1-7 When on their way through the desert the Israelites get angry with their leader Moses because they have no water, God lets Moses strike a rock with his staff to provide water.
- Psalms 95 This psalm remembers the incident of the water-giving rock but also how the people grumbled against God.
- Romans 5:1-11 Jesus Christ, through his death, has established peace between us and God, not because we were such wonderful people, but out of unconditional love.
- John 4:5-42 When Jesus asks a woman at a well to give him some water, this simple request turns into a conversation in which Jesus reveals himself as the source of life.

Paul underlines how astonishing it is that Jesus Christ gave his life for us. Can you figure it out?
