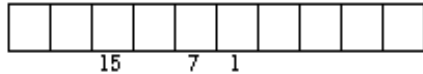


A DIFFERENT ANGLE

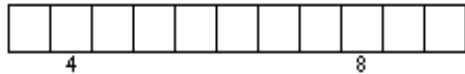
As the apostle Paul explains to the Corinthians, through Jesus Christ we have gained a new perspective on Christ himself, on other people and on ourselves.
