Reformation Sunday

October 31, 2021

On October 31st 1517 the German monk, priest and university teacher Martin Luther published 95 theses about what he thought was going wrong in the Church. That started the Reformation.

Today's lessons:

- Jeremiah 31:31-34 God promises his people a New Covenant, this time not giving the Law (= the rules of the covenant) written in stone like he did with Moses, but God will put his Law into the hearts and the minds of his people.
- Psalm 46 Even when everything in our life looks like chaos and nobody seems to be on our side, God will be there for us.
- Romans 3:19-28 The Apostle Paul explains that we will not be justified in God's eyes by fulfilling the Law – because we always fail to do so – but will be justified by God's own grace.
- John 8:31-36 Jesus explains to his listeners that only if sin has no longer power over them they will be really free.
