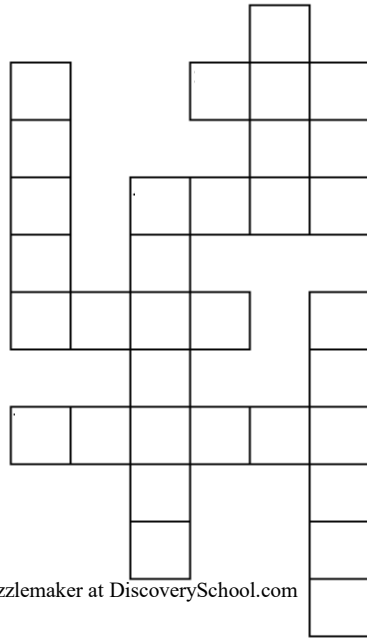

- FATHER

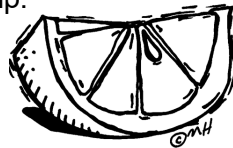

I AM ON THE ACCELERATED ORANGE !



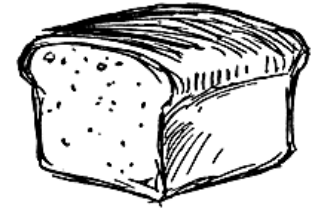

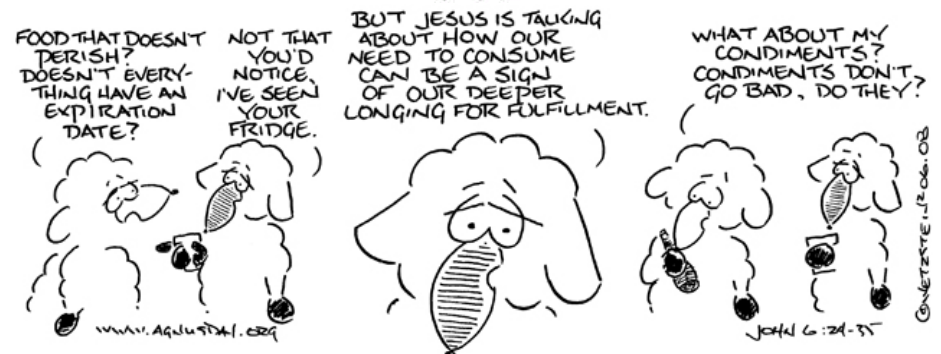


Today's lessons:

- 2 Samuel 11:26 – 12:13a After King David got Bathsheba pregnant and sent her husband to death, God sends the prophet Nathan to him to confront him. Nathan does so by telling David a story that holds a mirror up to the king and his actions.
- Psalm 51:1-12 All offenses against whomsoever are really sins against God himself (as they are violations of his commandments). And only he can free us from our guilt.
- Ephesians 4:1-16 As members of the Church we all share one faith, but have received different gifts. And yet all these gifts are to serve the same purpose: the building up of the body of Christ (= the Church).
- John 6:24-35 After Jesus has fed the 5000, people won't let him go. They feel reminded of Moses and the Manna in the desert. But Jesus corrects them: what happens now, with him, is even better!
