Today's lessons:

- 1 Samuel 15:34 - 16:13 Saul, the first king of Israel, has acted against God's will. Now God sends his prophet Samuel to anoint one of the sons of Jesse as king instead. It turns out God has not chosen one of the seven very impressive sons Jesse shows to Samuel, but the youngest one, David.
- Psalm 20 This psalm is asking God for support for 'the anointed one' (= the king).
- 2 Corinthians 5:6-17 The apostle Paul reminds the Corinthians to look at life from a perspective of faith, or actually from God's perspective: God has made us new, and everything else, too!
- Mark 4:26-34 Jesus tells two parables about God's kingdom: it grows by itself like seed once it has been sown, and it grows into something bigger than we would ever have expected.

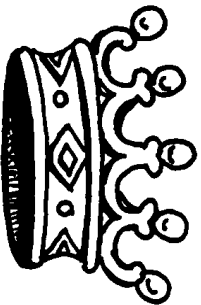
