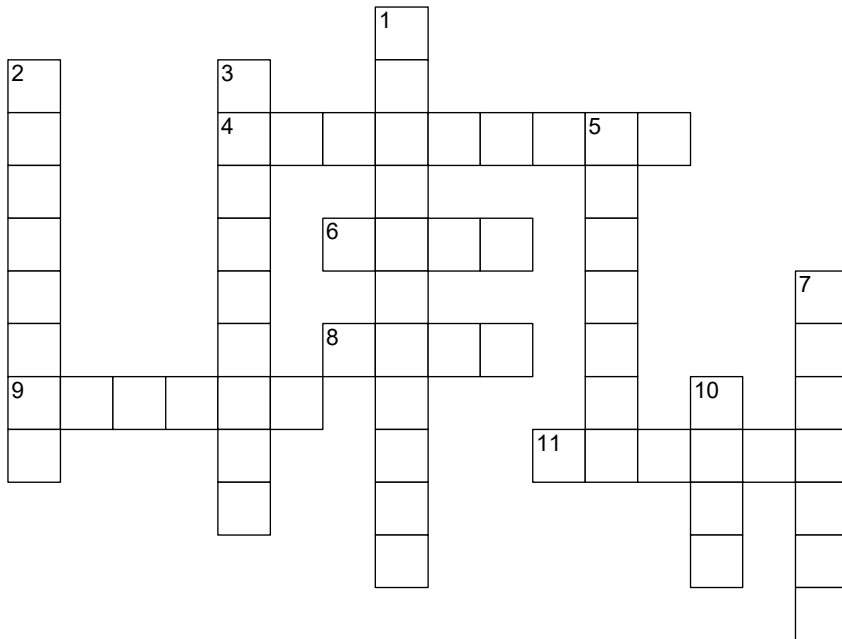


# A BALANCED LIFESTYLE

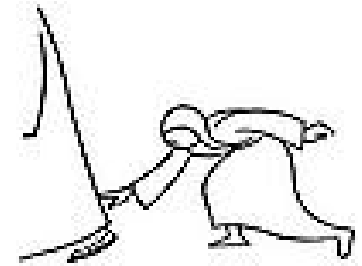

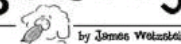

## Today's lessons:

- 2 Samuel 1:1, 17-27 When he hears that King Saul and his son Jonathan are dead, David writes this song of mourning in honour of them.
- Psalm 130 This psalm takes the perspective of someone in a deep, deep hole, and knows that his own actions have brought him into this position.
- 2 Corinthians 8:7-15 The apostle Paul gives the Corinthians a friendly reminder that they have committed the year before to helping the Christians in Jerusalem financially. God's justice means that all have enough.
- Mark 5:21-43 Jesus is on his way to the severely ill daughter of Jairus, the leader of a synagogue, when he is held up by a woman who is also sick. The woman touches Jesus' clothes and is healed. When Jesus comes to Jairus' house the daughter has died, but that doesn't stop Jesus!

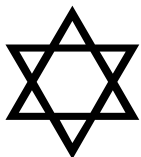
