And all the words from that psalm listed below are present in this word-search – even if it may take you a while to discover them – just like the presence of God is not always obvious.

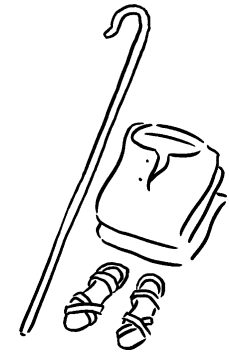

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# Youth Bulletin

## Today's lessons:

- 2 Samuel 5:1-5, 9-10 David who is already king over Judah (the southern part of Israel) is asked by the northern tribes (Israel in the narrower sense) to be their king, too. The capital of the joint kingdom becomes Jerusalem.
- Psalm 48 This psalm celebrates Jerusalem because of God's presence in this city.
- 2 Corinthians 12:2-10 The apostle Paul knows that the Corinthians would rather listen to somebody with an impressive record. But he prefers not to boast about his achievements; rather the Corinthians should base their decisions only on what Jesus Christ has done for them.
- Mark 6:1-13 When Jesus comes to his hometown of Nazareth, people don't want to listen to him, questioning his authority. Then Jesus sends out his disciples to preach repentance, but prepares them for similar disappointments.
