

Today's lessons:

Acts 9:36-43	In the first Christian churches it was often the women, esp. the widows who were the backbone of the community. When the widow Tabitha dies, the apostle Peter brings her back to life.
Psalm 23	The relationship between God and his people is like that between a shepherd and his sheep.
Revelation 7:9-17	The prophet John witnesses how a multitude of people brings their praises before God's throne. He learns that these are the saints, the people who have been cleansed by the blood of Christ the Lamb. As we all have in our Baptism
John 10:22-30	Jesus talks about himself as the shepherd of the people: those who belong to him will recognize him and will come to him and will be safe forever.


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Sister Acts
