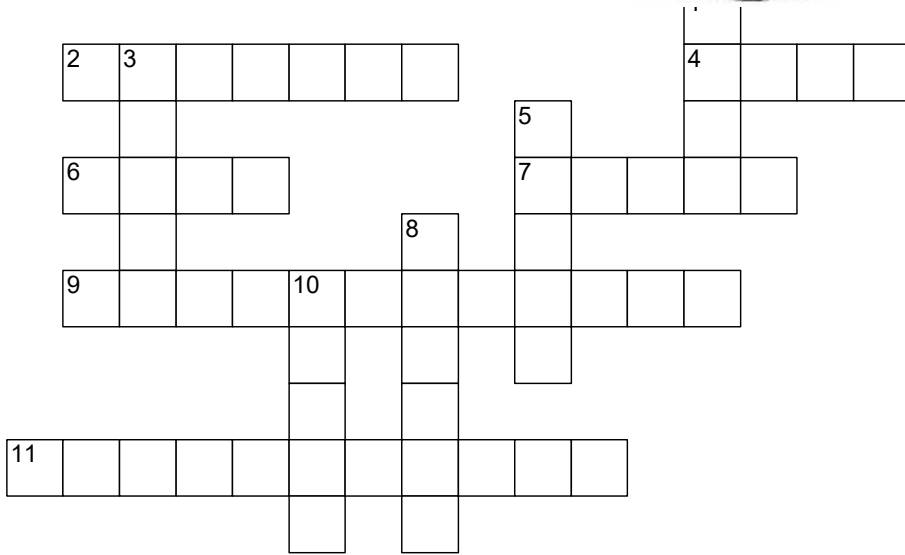


Saved Through Water

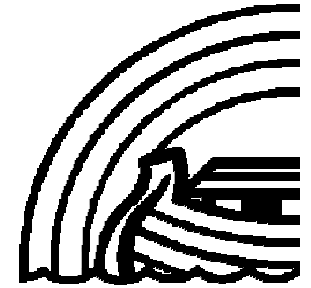

Today's lessons:

- Genesis 9:8-17 After all living creatures, apart from Noah and those who were with him in the ark, have died in the Flood, God promises never again to destroy the earth by a flood.
- Psalms 25:1-10 A prayer for forgiveness and guidance.
- 1 Peter 3:18-22 Just like Noah and his family did not die in the waters of the Flood, we don't die in the water of Baptism. In both cases the water washes away all sin. But this time the only one to die is Jesus Christ...
- Mark 1:9-15 Immediately after Jesus' baptism, the Spirit leads him into the desert, where the devil puts him to the test for forty days. But Jesus withstands temptation and returns to proclaim the Gospel.
